





All competitors participating in the 42nd Can-Am Sport Kickboxing Divisions must be registered with the BC Athletic Commission, prior to May 28, 2024.

All medical examinations and tests (i.e. physical examination, eye examination and blood tests) must have been conducted no more than 90 days before the date of application.

This year, competitors are to be matched to fight only once for the championship belt. All competitors will be matched closely in accordance to their body weight, training experience and ring experience.

To ensure the safety of participants, all referees, judges, and competitors are required to adhere to the guidelines outlined by the B.C. Athletic Commission. For detailed information, please visit our Sport Kickboxing Rules on SmoothComp.




NEW LION DANCE COMPETITION DIVISION



Placing

- the team with the fastest final time will take 1st place, the second highest final score 2nd place, and so-on
- Final score is determined by time of crossing the finish line plus any added time for error or omissions
- a disqualified team will receive no score/time

OBSTACLE RACING

Prescribed Route

Team takes its position behind start line
Team performs Lion Worship Ceremony 3 times (bow)
Whistle/Signal to begin, team leaves start line and time starts

- 1. Perform a head lift movement and turn 360 degrees
- 2. lion head jump onto long bench, lions runs across bench
- 3. lion duck under and jump over hurdles 4 times
- 4. lion must retrieve Qing
- 5. lion deposits Qing into the basket and runs across finish line

Deviation from the route or direction will result in error deduction


